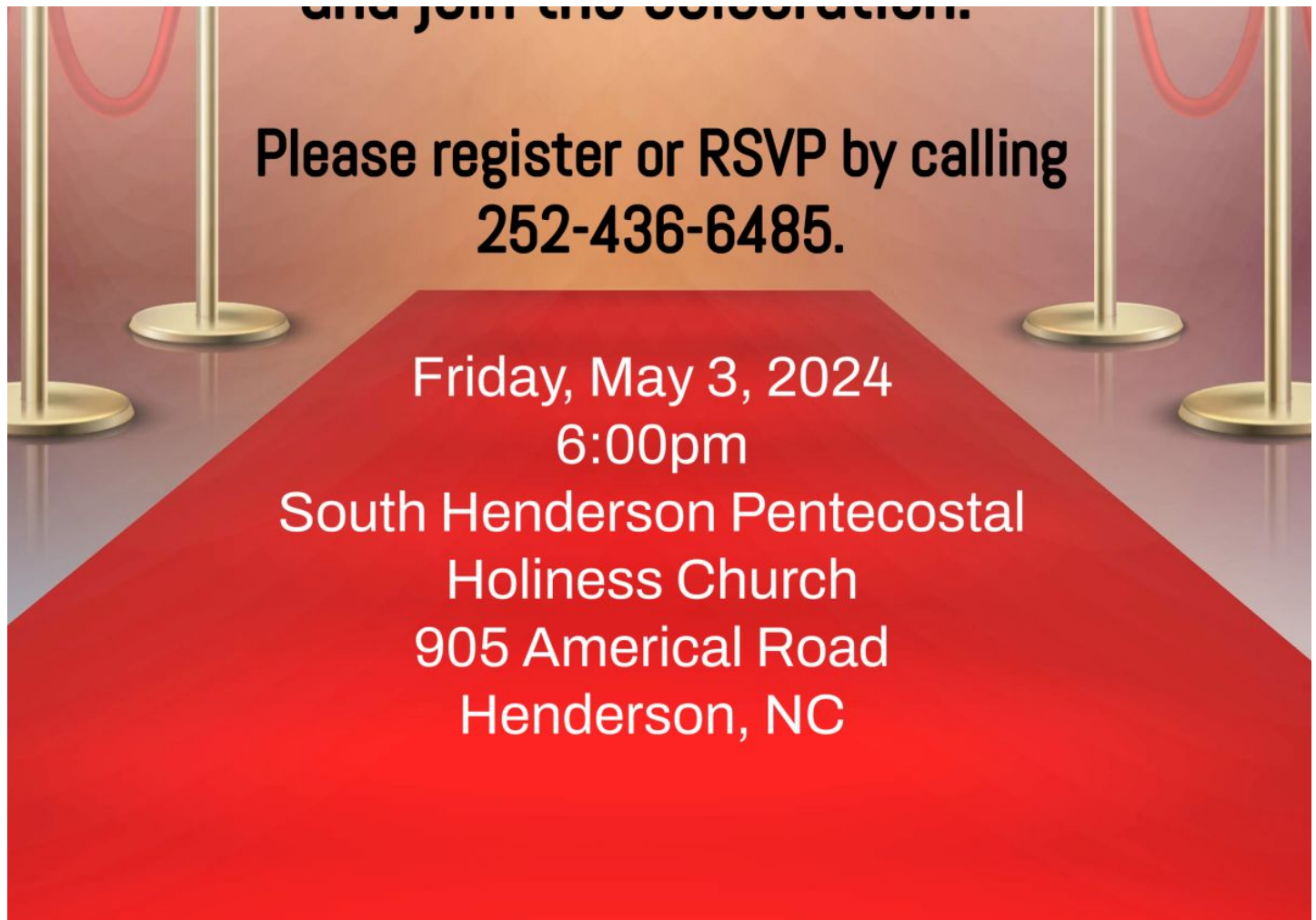
**Cancer Survivor Dinner**
